PRODUCT/AREA: Print

Print images with a black fill

By default, ID Builder sends the design to the print in Separate Render, that is, ID Builder sends 2 files to the driver, one with the RGB data and another with the Monochrome data. This leads to a better usage of the K ribbon during the print job.

When printing designs where an image has a Black background fill or a Black object behind, it is normal for the print result of the image to be a K black rectangle.

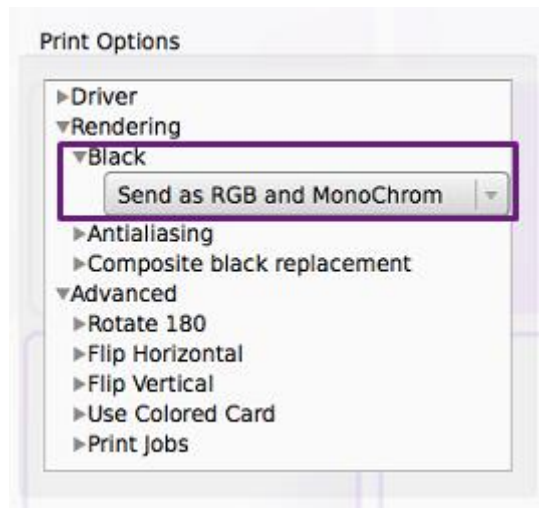


To overcome this behavior, we need to change how ID Builder sends the renders the data for the printer.

This can be done by accessing the **Print Settings** in ID Builder.



And change the **Rendering -> Black**, from Separate Render to **Send as RGB and Monochrome**.



Send the print job.
